Division Eligibility Rules for WFDF Ultimate Events

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1. Divisions – Gender and Age limitations

1.1. General

Each team has to be registered into one of the following divisions.

1.2. Gender Limitations

- 1.2.1. Open - Any person may participate in the Open Division.
- 1.2.2. Women - Any person who is female may participate in the Women's Division.
- 1.2.3. Mixed - Any person may participate in the Mixed Division. A mixed team is required to field both male and female players.

1.3. Age Limitations

Each of the three gender-based divisions may also be played with the following age limits

- 1.3.1. U19 (19 and Under) - A player participating in the U19 division must be eighteen (18) years old or younger on January 1 of the year of the event. The player is therefore under nineteen (19) at the beginning of the year of the event.
- 1.3.2. U23 (23 and Under) - A player participating in the U23 division must be twenty-two (22) years old or younger on January 1 of the year of the event. The player is therefore under twenty-three (23) at the beginning of the year of the event.
- 1.3.3. Master - A player participating in the Master division must be thirty-three (33) years old or older on December 31 of the year of the event.
- 1.3.4. Women Master - A player participating in the Women Master division must be thirty (30) years old or older on December 31 of the year of the event
